### **Summary**

#### **DAILY Notes**

**Temperature** (all relate to September): The minimum on 1st, 15.9 was the 6th highest reading in 35 years. The minimum on the 4th, 16.2c was the 4th highest in 35 years. The minimum on the 5th, 17.5c was the highest in 35 years of Bracknell Harmanwater records and the 2nd highest locally since records began in 1904. The maximum on the 4th was the 3rd highest in 35 years.

**Rainfall:** 8.9mm fell in 10 mins during a thunderstorm on the 4th.

#### **MONTHLY STATION NOTES**

Temperature: Mean Maximum 21.0c was the 3rd highest, Mean Minimum 11.5c the 3rd highest and mean 16.2c the 2nd highest all in the past 35 years.
